A Shorter Version of the Ancient Synagogue Liturgy

**WE HEAR THE MEDITATION**

(Isaiah 58:) 6 “Is not this the fast that I choose? To loose the bonds of wickedness, to undo the straps of the yoke, to let the oppressed go free, and to break every yoke? 7 Is it not to share your bread with the hungry and bring the homeless poor into your house; when you see the naked, to cover him, and not to hide yourself from your own flesh? 8 Then shall your light break forth like the dawn, and your healing shall spring up speedily; your righteousness shall go before you; the radiance of YHWH shall be your rear guard.”

**WE BLESS YHWH AND HEAR THE QOL SHOFAR**

Blessed are you, YHWH our Elohim, Sovereign of the Universe,  
**Who sanctifies us by your mitzvot and calls us to hear the qol shofar.**  
(The Shofar Master sounds the Tekiah.)

**WE BLESS MESSIAH**

Blessed are you, YHWH our Elohim, Sovereign of the Universe.  
**Who has given us the way of escape in Messiah Yahshua. Amein.**  
**So with joy we draw living water from the springs of deliverance!**

**WE BLESS EACH OTHER**

On that day Jacob blessed his grandchildren, he said, “In time to come, the people of Yisrael will use you as a blessing.  
They will say, ‘May Elohim make you like Ephraim and Menashe’.” (Genesis 48:20)  
**May Elohim make you like Ephraim and Menashe!**  
May Elohim make you like Sarah, Rivka, Ra-chel and Layah!  
**May Elohim make you like Sarah, Rivka, Ra-chel and Layah!**  
May Elohim bless you and watch over you!  
**May Elohim shine His face toward you and show you favor!**  
May Elohim be favorably disposed towards you and grant you peace!

**WE ENTER THE QADOSH**

How lovely are your tents, O Ya’aqov, your dwelling places, Yisrael.  
**Through your abundant favor we will enter your home;**  
In awe we will bow down within your Qadosh Qadoshim.  
**We love the home you live in and the place where your radiance resides.**  
We will fall and bow, bending the knee before YHWH our Maker.  
May our prayers to you be at the appropriate time.  
**In your abundant righteousness, answer us with the truth of your Rescue.**

## **WE FAVOR KIN AND TALMIDIM**

May it be your will, YHWH our Elohim and Elohim of our fore-parents, that you show favor to us and all our friends and relations; and that you grant us and all in Yisrael a good and long life; that you remember us with good thoughts and blessings; that you consider us with your salvation and your compassion; that you bless us with great gifts and favors; that you make our households complete; that you cause your Presence to dwell among us at all times.

**Privilege us to train up our youth, proselytes, disciples – and all talmidim – in wisdom, understanding, in loving and revering YHWH, in belonging to Yahshua the Anointed One and being committed to him. Let them be people of truth, qadosh for YHWH, to illuminate the world with Torah and tov mitzvot, doing all in the service of YHWH. Hear our supplication right now, and give us the same favor as our spiritual mothers and fathers. Cause our light to shine as a reflection of your face for all ages, so that all Yisrael might be saved. Amein.**

## **WE RECITE THE SHEMA**

Hear O Yisrael, YHWH is our Elohim, YHWH is One. Blessed is the name of his esteemed kingdom forever.

**And you will love YHWH your Elohim with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your might, and you will love your neighbor as yourself.**

**Let these words be upon your heart. You will teach them diligently to your children And speak of them when you sit in your house, when you walk upon the path, when you retire, and when you arise. And you will bind them for a sign upon your hand - and let them be frontlets between your eyes. And you will write them on the doors and gates of your house.**

**... And you will love your neighbor as yourself.**

## **WE GIVE THANKS AND PRAISE** *(The Chazan (hyzan) takes down the liturgy.)*

*{Here you may sing psalms, give witness, articulate prayer requests.}*

*{The Leader of the Prayer Service here prays for each request.}*

*{The Chazan returns the liturgy to the screen.}*

## **WE HEAR THE WORD AND TESTIMONY**

Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in your sight, O YHWH, our strength, and our redeemer!

*(The appropriate text may here be recited. Or not.)*

**Amein! Let the Prophets Prophecy!**

*(The Chazan takes down the liturgy.)*

*(The Leader introduces the speaker and speaks and anointing blessing upon him or her.)*

### **WE PRAY TOGETHER**

Our Father in the Sky, may your name be sanctified.

**May your Reign be blessed; your will be done in Sky and Land. Continually give us our bread; forgive us our sin-debts as we forgive the debt of those who sin against us. Do not bring us into the nets of a snare, and protect us from the evil one. Amein.**

### **THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE** (*Repeat after me:*)

**I pledge allegiance to the TORAH  
of the Kingdom of the Beloved Son,  
and to the divine theocracy for which it stands.**

**One Eloha, one Nation, one Head,  
one faith, one attitude, one goal,  
one baptism, one communion,  
ordained by YHWH the creator.**

**My Nation is indivisible;  
with divine liberty, equitable justice  
and eternal life for all. Amein.**

### **THE LEADER BLESSES**

YHWH bless you and keep you, YHWH make his face shine upon you and be gracious to you, YHWH lift up his countenance upon you and give you peace! In the Name of Yahshua ha Mashiach, Prince of Peace, **Ahmein!**
